



- **PRESENCE:**
  - Christ is present in the Eucharist, in the Mass and in the priest.
  - Christ is the catalyst to transform us.
  - Be an ‘echo of the Eucharist’ in your Small Church Communities.
  
- **GIFT:**
  - Christ’s whole life, the cross, the resurrection teaches us to “be gift”.
  - ‘Re-gifting’ Christ is what we are to be to the world.
  - We need to be “Goal oriented” towards “the way of Christ”.
  - Sacrament is a mystery. It is the time, place and means by which God enters into our world.
  - The Eucharist is a “breaking in” of God’s power into our world.
  - The rest of the sacraments are just a continuation.
  - We need to “make a space” for God in our lives, family and SCC.
  
- **COMMUNION:**
  - Communion is the ultimate goal, to be “one-on-one” with God.
  - Christ is the “glue” between God and us.
  - He helps us form our relationship with God.
  
- **PLEDGE:**
  - Pledge is just not a “promise for the future”, but “a down-payment” for now.
  - Real equals “now”. We have begun our journey in eternity.
  - We are living the pledge at the Groom’s dinner, now.
  - Rejoice in what is to come.
